Registration Costs: Please turn payment in full with registration. Checks may be made out to “Hyde Park Community UMC,” please include students name and ski trip on memo line. Cost of the trip includes transportation, 3 nights lodging, most meals, t-shirt, all skiing costs. If cost is a prohibitive factor in a student participating please contact student ministries director Ken Miller (567.204.3518) to work out arrangements.

No equipment rental: \$325 Ski and Helmet Rental: \$400 Ski/Helmet Rental and ski Lesson: \$430

Families with 2 participates can take 5% off total cost

Families with 3 or more participants and adult counselors can take 10% off total cost.

Trip Details: We will meet at Hyde Park Community church at 4:30 pm on Friday and return about midafternoon on Monday. Please eat dinner on Friday before we go or pack a lunch for the bus. You will need money with you for two meals and we suggest about \$25 (one at the ski resort and one on the road on Monday). Should you need to reach us during the weekend please call Ken Miller at 567.204.3518. We will be staying overnight at Camp Allegheny (www.campallegheny.com) and skiing at Seven springs ski resort (www.7springs.com). **All Forms and monies are due by Jan 2nd.** After the second, we will accept students only if we have extra room with transportation and lodging. We must have a minimum of 20 participants for the ski weekend to happen.

All students will take a lesson the first day of the trip unless a parent or guardian considers their child an intermediate or advanced skier and gives permission to not participate in a lesson. All students will be required to wear a helmet.

Student Expectations so we can all have a great weekend:

Be Present. Be open to the experiences this weekend, get to know those around you better, and seek to connect with God this weekend.

This is Not a date. Please no displays of affection.

Be safe. Stay with the group, follow instructions, don't ski beyond your abilities etc.

Be Respectful. Treat others with kindness. Guys and Girls sleeping rooms/bath rooms are off limits to the opposite gender. Be listeners when others are sharing. Obey quiet hours. No bullying, practical jokes etc.

Be Responsible. Be punctual. Clean up your own messes. Be willing to chip in and help out when asked.

Don't do harmful stuff. Don't do anything illegal or harmful to others or self (cutting, gossip, smoking, alcohol, weapons, fireworks, etc.). And yes whining is harmful.
