A note from Matthew Covert:

In John 20:19-31 there is wonderful story of Jesus, appearing to the disciples. I like to think of our Lord as having a great sense of humor. I have to believe that it is possible for Him to just "appear" in the room and say, "peace be with you!" I'll tell you, if a guy just appeared in the room, standing beside me, I'd jump right out of my skin and there would be a Matthewshaped hole in the wall. But Jesus shows up, says "Peace," and there was peace. The part of this story that stands out to me is Thomas, who always gets a bad rep for doubting. I understand that we need to have faith, but I can actually see some positives here. Thomas didn't rely on someone else's experience. He didn't follow blindly after the crowd. He waited for his own experience and when he had it, he was 100% committed. Like the other Apostles, Thomas was martyred for his testimony. He was faithful to the end. There's also a word in this story pointed straight at us from our Lord. In verse 29 Jesus says, "Happy are those who don't see and yet believe." Jesus was starring straight through time and space, right at us.
