Since then, the group has become a community chorus and performed under several different names, the last being The Patchwork Singers. In the Autumn of 2000 the group realized that most of its members lived in places close to I-275 - the "circle" freeway around the greater Cincinnati area - and changed its name to Circle Singers. Circle Singers repertoire includes a wide variety of musical styles: Broadway favorites, contemporary, patriotic, folk, spirituals, classical, religious, and old standards.
