FEEDING CHILDREN DURING **COVID 19**

On Tuesday, March 17th, our church started distributing meals daily to children as a way to fill in the gap while school buildings are closed and children are learning from home. The Warehouse, the second campus of HPCUMC, was an additional distribution site from Thursday, March 19 – Sunday, March 22 before the second site was moved to our partner church, State Ave UMC, in Lower Price Hill. Any child 18 and under can come and pick up 3 shelf stable meals daily, they do not need to live in the Hyde Park or Lower Price Hill to receive the meals. So far, over 1,500 meals have been distributed and 86 people have stepped up to help out. The best part is, over 60% of the people serving are from the community, wanting to lend a hand! Not only is this feeding initiative a mission of the church it is an effective outreach!

We can use your support as we continue this feeding ministry through at least April:
