LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:2,6)

We celebrate God's holy movement in the lives of ordinary people, like Zechariah, the father of John the Baptist. In spite of his questions and disappointment, Zechariah still worshipped God. As we light this first candle of Advent, we join our voices with his, lifting our song of hope to God:
